Exodus 40:17-21, 34-38

¹⁷In the first month in the second year, on the first day of the month, the tabernacle was erected. ¹⁸Moses erected the tabernacle. 
EPISTLE Titus 3:4-7

HOLY GOSPEL

John 1:1–14

¹In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ²He was in the beginning with God. ³All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. ⁴In him was life, and the life was the light of men. ⁵The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

C I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible.



I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins, and I look for the resurrection of the dead and the life + of the world to come. Amen.







shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."




AGNUS DEI
