

**EXHORTATION** *LSB 151* 

- If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

In fact, I do not even judge myself. <sup>4</sup>I am not aware of anything against myself, but I am not thereby acquitted. It is the Lord who judges me. <sup>5</sup>Therefore do not pronounce judgment before the time, before the Lord comes, who will bring to light the things now

hidden in darkness and will disclose the purposes of the heart. Then each one will receive his commendation from God.

"'Behold, I send my messenger before your face, who will prepare your way before you.'


