



Isaiah 9:2-7






GOSPEL

Luke 2:1-14

In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. This was the first registration when Quirinius was governor of Syria. And all went to be registered, each to his own town. And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the town of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, to be registered with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child. And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn. And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. saying, "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased!" (ESV)






NICENE CREED


And I believe in one holy Christian and apostolic






SERVICE OF THE SACRAMENT




THE WORDS OF INSTITUTION

Turn to the person next to you and, holding your lit candle upright, allow them to light their candle from yours. **The lit candle always remains upright**.
