




### READINGS FROM HOLY SCRIPTURE

**1ST READING** *Joel 2:12-19* 

12"Yet even now," declares the LORD, "return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning; 13 and rend your hearts and not your garments." Return to the LORD, your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love; and he relents over disaster. 14Who knows whether he will not turn and relent, and leave a blessing behind him, a grain offering and a drink offering for the LORD your God? <sup>15</sup>Blow the trumpet in Zion; consecrate a fast; call a solemn assembly; <sup>16</sup>gather the people. Consecrate the congregation; assemble the elders; gather the children, even nursing infants. Let the bridegroom leave his room, and the bride her chamber. <sup>17</sup>Between the vestibule and the altar let the priests, the ministers of the LORD, weep and say, "Spare your people, O LORD, and make not your heritage a reproach, a byword among the nations. <sup>2</sup>May grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord.






**3RD READING** John 8:31-36






Taught by our Lord and trusting His promises, we are bold to pray:

For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.






